

- **August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008:** It gives us great pleasure to announce that, once again, American General Supplies was selected from several competitors to handle parts provisioning for LAM Mozambique Airlines 2 ea newly acquired Bombardier DHC-8-Q-400 aircraft.

LAM Mozambique Airlines considered the efficient services of AGS and the long standing business relations between the two organizations and signed a Provisioning Agreement that commenced on August 2008 and will be completed in the early part of 2009.

LAM Mozambique Airlines purchased two used DHC-8-Q400 aircraft from SAS. These turboprop Aircrafts were manufactured by Bombardier in the year 2000 and used by SAS for 8 years necessitating good maintenance with a strong parts supply support.

Despite the fact that the provisioning agreement was signed late, American General Supplies shall use its expertise and connections to expedite the provisioning exercise to protect LAM Mozambique Airlines' domestic operation with these aircraft.

The Airline has also ordered two (2) each Brazilian Embraer 190 Jet Airplanes having 105-110 seat capacity, for delivery in June/ July 2009. Although an agreement has not yet been signed, an arrangement has been made between the two organizations for AGS to continue with the Provisioning exercise for these aircraft also as soon as the Provisioning for the DHC-8-Q400 is completed.

It is gratifying to note that LAM Mozambique Airlines is also entrusting the warranty administration and component repair and overhaul to AGS in order to have a one stop, all round service provider at its disposal.

LAM Mozambique Airlines was encouraged to give the responsibility to AGS knowing that AGS successfully carried out a provisioning exercise for TAAG Angola Airlines B737 and B777 Fleet.

The Senior Vice President Sales and Purchasing, Mr. Teddy Kassa, was nominated to be in charge of the project in coordination with Mr. Joel David, Vice President of Purchasing and LAM Mozambique Airlines Representative, Mr. Jaime Preco.

We would like to echo the call of the Chairman and President of AGS, Mr. Kassa Maru for the usual cooperation of each and every employee to join hands and make this undertaking a success.
